Alerion authorised to build a new wind farm in San Marco in Lamis (Foggia) with a power capacity of 72.6 MW

Alerion Clean Power S.p.A., a company listed on the Italian Stock Exchange and operating in the renewable energy sector, has been authorised to build a wind farm in San Marco in Lamis (Foggia) with a power capacity of 72.6 MW.

The San Marco in Lamis plant will have a production in the range of 130 – 140 GWh/year, depending on the final lay-out of the plant. The investment for the plant will be in the range of Euro 95 – 105 million and it will be funded through company's financial resources and project financing, for which the company is already in advanced negotiation with banks.

"Authorisation for the construction of the San Marco in Lamis plant – commented Giulio Antonello, Chief Executive Officer of Alerion Clean Power S.p.A. – is an important step ahead in our development plan, which will bring to approximately 300 MW the power capacity of operating and under construction plants in the renewable energy sector, positioning Alerion as one of the most significant sector players in the Italian and European markets."
