### Alerion Clean Power:

- **agreement signed to develop solar power plants in Romania with total capacity of around 200 MW**
- **is awarded the incentive tariff in the last auction announced by the GSE for a wind power plant of 12.6 MW in Cerignola**

**Milan, 10 February 2021** – Alerion Clean Power has signed a collaboration agreement with PV Project RO to develop solar power plants in Romania. Under the agreement, solar power plants with total installed capacity of around 200 MW will be developed. Some of these plants, with total installed power of around 33 MW, are scheduled to begin operating by the end of the first half of this year.

We can also announce that Alerion, through its subsidiary Naonis Wind S.r.l., which is authorised to build a wind power plant in the municipality of Cerignola (Puglia) with power of around 12.6 MW, was awarded an incentive tariff of around 68.5 €/MWh for a period of 20 years in the last FER auction announced by the GSE (Energy Services Manager).

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
